Football Tour to New Zealand 2019

The 2019 Football New Zealand Tour was an incredible experience for all boys as we enjoyed the amazing facilities that the High-Performance Sport Centre had to offer, alongside Lou Mazzoleni's amazing touring expertise of the beautiful city that is Auckland. We landed in Auckland on Sunday, April 7, and with little time left in the day, we all quickly unpacked and explored the centre, played table tennis and got to know each other much more. Once Lou informed us all of the Subway that was attached to the premises, it quickly became a hot spot for the boys that were still hungry.

Our second day saw both the senior and junior teams have their first game against Kirstin. We had very little knowledge of the team we were about to face, but with the fields looking pristine the boys were keen to get into it. The juniors kicked off first with the seniors followed soon after. The juniors first game took place on Monday against a young and talented team from Kristin School. Ashgrove dominated both halves, but Kristin showed great fight and flair in a comfortable 5-0 win for Marist.

The seniors were next to take the field, being undermanned with three injured players and no subs, we were lucky to have Riley Mcilhatton-Saunders step up after his game and join us on the bench making his debut for the team. With a comfortable first-half, we all seemed to settle into the chilly conditions and safely secured a 9-1 victory.

The third day consisted of both teams second game against Rosmini. As we turned up the school lunch bell sounded, and we found ourselves being surrounded by passing students and realised the quality of the opposition. The junior team played first with the senior team closely followed, allowing the senior team to support the juniors. Being considered one of the best teams in Auckland, the juniors knew they would have to put in the hard yards to get a victory. After starting positively with many promising attacks, we were unable to take our chances. Rosmini pounced on their opportunities and delivered us a humbling 5-0 loss. It was a great experience to play in front of over 200 students, who created a great atmosphere at the game.

With a little more knowledge of the team we were about to face, the senior team were inspired to follow up the first win with another. With a poor first, drawing 1-1, there was a lot of work to be done in the next half. As the second half commenced all the boys put in an amazing shift to win the game 5-1, with some of the best performances on the tour.

The fourth day was our sightseeing day, where we experienced the Auckland war memorial museum, the sky tower and a speed boat ride throughout the harbour. The museum displayed a range of unique culture and history like; traditional weapons, fishing items, boats and huts. There was a performance of the traditional dances and games that the Maori's use to and still partake in. Following the museum, we left to the sky tower. A 360° view of the city allowed for everyone to see the city in all its beauty. The final stop after lunch was the speed boat ride with a very enthusiastic driver. Whilst on the ride the driver would give us information on Auckland and its rich history

The senior team were extremely excited to end the tour on a high and win the game. With Riley now being inserted into the starting XI, we kicked off and played a brilliant first half leading 2-0. The first goal saw an incredible goal from great teamwork between Ben Braunstorfer and Zac Kierpal. The second started with beautiful footwork from Riley, skinning two players then passing to Ben who played a perfect through ball to Zac Kierpal where he hits his first goal in the top corner.
