Last weekend we hosted St. Edmund's College in the major AIC round the majority of competition. While many results were certainly in our favour we commend SEC for continuing to compete in every match despite the scoreline. A great example of sportsmanship at its finest occurred in the 9A rugby game which was a very competitive game decided by one try in the end.

An Ashgrove student made a break and was running down the field when he injured his hip flexor. A student on the SEC team who was chasing knew something was wrong and in a fantastic display of sportsmanship put his hand up straight away to protect the Ashgrove student from being tackled. His teammates also showed the same concern. An impressive display of sportsmanship and the SEC boys in that team are a credit to their school.

This was a split-second decision from the SEC student which could have ended up much worse for the injured Ashgrove student and in a close game it is good to see true sportsmanship still exists.

Our chess teams performed exceptionally well not losing a match against their SEC rivals with 4 wins and 1 draw. They will be hoping to continue this form when they face Villanova this Friday away at Coorparoo. As always, the Chess competition is very close and we wish our boys the best in the remaining rounds to determine who comes out on top.

In rugby we were successful in all aggregate matches with some very dominant results from several teams. Many teams are undefeated heading into the final 3 rounds and with several big clashes coming up our boys will need to be at their best every week. ROUND 4 VS SEC – SATURDAY, MAY 25, 2019

1st XI Rugby Vs St Edmund's: Result 79-0

Even though there are some big matches to finish the season, the team remained focused on their Round 4 opponents. While there was some excellent attack to pile on the points, it was the defensive effort when under pressure for an extended period that was most pleasing. Many bench players received their opportunity and allowed some starters to rest up for what will be a tough few games to end the season.

3rd XV	The 3rds vs 4ths Opens Rugby fixture did not disappoint. It was a wonderful game of footy played with passion and determination. The 4ths won the battle of the rucks for most of the first half and the glut of possession saw the scores stay very tight. Euston Knox and Wade Makini were well supported by Dom Malt and Archie Miller. All these boys would play a much higher grade in other schools. The second half saw the backs in thirds run away and a great game by Oliver Haddad was the icing on the cake.
5th XV	A solid start from the boys running in two tries within the first 10 minutes. Boys got complacent towards the end of the first half, with loose defence in the middle of the ruck. Try conversions ended up being the difference in the game, with Nick Fisher converting all goals for Marist.
