Rugby - Team Reports and Results

ROUND 5 VS VILLA – SATURDAY, JUNE 1, 2019

1st XV Rugby vs Villanova: Result 31-10 win

A fantastic contest was played between the only undefeated teams in the 1st XV competition. As expected, Villanova threw everything at our team and the boys maintained their defensive integrity throughout the first half to hold a 19-0 lead. A few errors gave Villa easy field position and being down to only 14 men for twenty minutes of the 2nd half; our defensive line was finally broken. With the game at 19-10 we finally gained some field position and scored two tries to complete a 31-10 win. Another full team effort where all players, including the bench, deserve recognition.

TEAM	TEAM REPORT
2nd XV	A composed game of running rugby, built on the back of a dominate defensive performance ensured the 2nd XV emerged victorious in their top of the table clash in Round 5. Led well from the back by Captain Max Mee and composure and disruption at set piece from Vice Captain Neasen Sheehan allowed the team to play their most consistent and rounded game to date. Tenacious defence and ball carrying from centre Riley Brown, and a busy, bustling performance from prop Lachlan McKarzel were among many highlights. The team now turn their attention to the final two rounds where it will be important to maintain their focus and continue to work hard on the finer details of our game play.
3rd XV	A much-improved shape by the team saw us score nine tries and bomb three. The first half saw some excellent running rugby by Rhonan Jenson and Tim Gibb and they were well supported by Oliver Haddad. Ben Blaker played his heart out in the middle and set a great platform. George Perrers was as reliable as ever and Jake Eustace again played a full game.
8B	"The 8 B's were "up" for the challenge. Villanova were victors last season 11-10 but reversed the result winning 48-7. Luka Manahan (Prop) led from the front making a number of determined and damaging runs. Ben Jeffrey's (No 8) communication skills were instrumental in motivating our forwards to dominate the breakdown. Max Chapman's (Hooker) lineout throwing was precise. Sova Pogara (Half Back) and Tom Mitchell (Fly Half) were outstanding. Jude Knapp (Inside Centre) and Jonah Titifanua (Outside Centre) had a day out. The 8 B's wish to thank Patrick Hooper (injured-out for season) for his attendance and support at the game today. It is actions like Patrick's that typifies the B's team culture. Team first! Round 5 v Padua College-the 8 B's are coming!
8C	Solid and controlled game from the team against a frequently spirited Villa team. An across the park team effort well represented by three tries each half with six different scorers. Zane and Cruz running in their first for the season effectively stranding fellow half Hunter to sit on the duck egg by himself. Only two games to go! Most pleasing aspect again the shutout with the boys showing good resolve and urgency when they were threatened. Another impressive team performance; special mentions to James Milner who bagged five tries with his ability to break the line and Ted Clark, in a sublime kicking display, kicked eight from 10 as well as scoring a try himself.
6B	After conceding the first try, the 6Bs bounced back with aggression and blew a determined Villa side off the park, the second half was all one-way traffic and the team worked together well as a group and produced their best game of the season.
6C	After conceding two early tries the boys were able to refocus against a much larger Villa pack and played a strong second half. Strong runs from Roy Peake and Harry Lundberg put the boys right back into game, only to fall one try short.
