### From the Head of Sport

Last Saturday saw the official end of the Term 1 sporting season with our cricket and volleyball teams playing the final round of AIC competition. These sports have some of the longest programs in College sport with preparation beginning back in late October and continuing throughout the Christmas holidays and early January. A special mention to the many students, staff and families all involved in making our programs such a success for Marist College Ashgrove.

Success in sport can be measured in many ways from the number of premierships and wins throughout the season to the large numbers of participants we successfully manage to retain each year in our sporting programs. This term we had 91 sporting teams play sport which is the largest number of teams we have ever had at this stage of year. While it can be difficult at times to manage the number of students we have playing sport we pride ourselves on providing all students with the opportunity to play sport. The eagerness to participate and represent the College has never been higher. Obviously, with such a large program the task of organising teams, coaches, draws and venues often against eight different colleges is enormous. We appreciate how understanding our community is in recognising the time and effort that goes into running a program of this magnitude and we certainly appreciate the positive feedback we have received throughout the term.

One of the highlights for the term was the involvement of our Year 7 and 8 students in our colours volleyball competition that led into the Friday afternoon doubleheaders with St. Laurence's as a fitting way to conclude their season. The enthusiastic involvement of many old boys and staff in coaching these students, most of who were learning volleyball for the first time, was great to see.

The AIC Volleyball competition was an unbelievably close competition this year with many colleges moving up and down the rankings. While our College teams maintained their 5th placing in the aggregate competition, I know our volleyball coaches and players were disappointed with this result. With only 2 rounds to go we were well placed to finish in the top 3 but unfortunately, some final results did not go our way and we slipped out of contention. A special mention must go to the 11A volleyball team, coached by Mr Trevor Goodwin as well as the 7A team coached by (our recent retiree who showed he's still got it) Mr Paul Kearney and the 7C team coached by Mr Scott Minogue who achieved co-premierships. Our sincerest thanks to Mr Adam Knight for his coordination of the volleyball program with Mr Scott Minogue. Both of these staff members worked extremely hard and are certainly passionate about seeing the program have success in the future.
